THE EASTER CELEBRATION CONTINUES!

Although the secular world might believe that Easter is in the past, the Church continues the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus all the way to Pentecost Sunday, May 29th, 2024. These weeks of celebration can help us to recognize the incredible love and mercy that God shows us through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

We have reason to celebrate the 1350 adults and children who prayed with us on Easter Sunday alone. So inspiring was our prayer together, that faith filled people of other faiths sought greater information on the process by which they can be formed, and ultimately initiated into the Catholic faith we profess. Incredible as it may sound, God is moving and acting in our midst. Join me in praying that we may all be vibrant witnesses to Jesus' resurrection, and in all things, deepen our trust in God's love and mercy.

The **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)** is the process by which Catholics can complete the initiation begun in baptism, Christians from other churches can be received into the Catholic church and those not baptized can be fully initiated by receiving the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and holy communion after a process of formation.
