

Parents, grandparents and guardians are reminded to accompany their children to the restroom in Church.


THE TABLET PRIEST ASSIGNMENTS

Although the summer has been quiet, the recent announcement of my Pastorate at Saint Augustine—Saint Francis Xavier led some to question why, after three years as Pastor, I was being named the Pastor. Currently in the midst of the merger process, Saint Augustine and Saint Francis Xavier, for the last three years, were still separate corporate entities. It is for that reason that we still maintained separate budgets and maintained separate accounts, even reminding generous parishioners and benefactors that checks needed to be addressed to either Saint Augustine OR Saint Francis Xavier. Recently I announced that the various committees that advise Bishop Brennan had approved the merger. Currently we await the longer process of merging into one corporate entity. With the Diocesan regulations met, the formality of assigning me as Pastor of Saint Augustine—Saint Francis Xavier was accomplished by the Bishop's appointment and announcement in the Tablet.

In addition to these formal announcements, we continue to move forward as we grow through the post-pandemic Church and world, epic deferred maintenance, and changes to ensure our strength as a Parish. I am grateful (even in the heat) for the prayer, witness, and care of so many as we advance forward in faith, hope and love.


