Today, after 9:30AM Mass we return to providing an opportunity for hospitality after Mass. Each opportunity for fellowship will be hosted either at the Parish Office (former Rectory of Saint Francis Xavier) or at Saint Monica Hall, located below Saint Augustine Church. Please consider joining us for some pastries and refreshments, but also an opportunity to visit with each other. Although we have not quite completed the extensive renovations that have been going on for the last 2 years—we are almost there! Please join us to see how much has been accomplished, and to help build our connection to one another in Christ.

I am grateful for those who volunteer as part of the hospitality committee who help us by planning, serving and cleaning after these events. Thank you for your service, generosity and care.

CONSIDER ARRIVING 10 MINUTES BEFORE THE STATED START TIME FOR MASS

Please consider arriving 10-15 minutes early to prepare for Mass.

Ideally, in unity, we are meant to pray together from the beginning of Mass to its end. Arriving during the readings from scripture fails to afford us to opportunity to pray together in the unity that Jesus came to bring. While it may take a sacrifice—it is important for us to plan on arriving early, if not on time.

Sadly, not everyone praying at Mass is able to receive holy communion. For clarity, those not able to receive Holy Communion are most welcome to pray with us. Those unable to receive should remain in their place in prayer. Catholic Christians who are able to receive should make a bow in reverence before receiving and answer the ministers' invitation of "The Body of Christ" with the clear answer "**Amen**". Our clear response of AMEN indicates that we say yes to Jesus in the Eucharist, and to God's plan for our salvation.

For those unable to receive, including children who have not made their first Communion, at the end of Mass, at the final blessing, a blessing is imparted to all present in hopes that the unity of Jesus Christ will be realized.

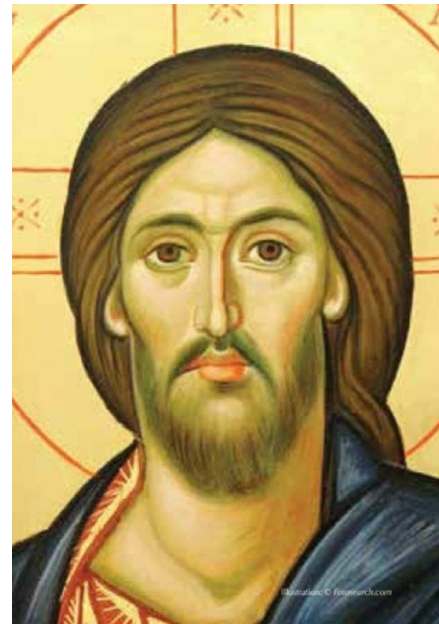


- All volunteers must be vetted before they can begin their service.
