**One Church. Diverse Ministries. United in Mission.**

The Diocese of Brooklyn, like most, if not all Dioceses in the United States, funds significant ministries by conducting an Annual Appeal to support various needed works. Ideally, this Annual Appeal (ACA) is able to provide for more needs more easily than any one parish can provide on its own. The theme of the 2026 ACA is “One Church. Diverse Ministries. United in Mission Every day, God gives us grace to respond to the Lord’s call to Communion, Participation and Mission. This invitation echoes the very heart of our faith: to walk together as disciples, rooted in prayer, strengthened by sacrifice, and committed to acts of charity.

The Parish goal for Saint Augustine~Saint Francis Xavier for the 2026 Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) is \$57,015. Since June 15, 2026, 89 pledges and one-time gifts totaling **\$64,750.** have been made. For those who have sacrificed to provide monthly payments on their pledge, we are just shy of \$10,000 in payments due. I am grateful for all those who have made a one-time gift or pledge.

Those seeking to make a pledge or one-time gift to support these important works can help us *exceed* the goal we’ve been assigned.

Any funds over goal are returned for use at Saint Augustine~Saint Francis Xavier. Last year, an impressive \$23,783. was returned for use within Parish programs.

Please continue to prayerfully consider how you may be able to sacrifice and support the works funded by the Diocese of Brooklyn’s Annual Catholic Appeal.

Catholic Christians who are able to receive should make a bow in reverence before receiving and answer the ministers’ invitation of “The Body of Christ” with the clear answer “Amen”.

Our clear response of AMEN indicates that we say yes to Jesus in the Eucharist, and to God’s plan for our salvation.

For those unable to receive, including children who have not made their first Communion, at the end of Mass, at the final blessing, a blessing is imparted to all present in hopes that the unity of Jesus Christ will be realized.

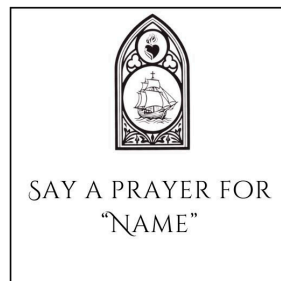
