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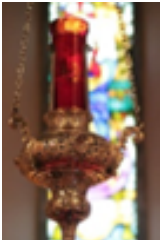

GUIDELINES FOR HOLY COMMUNION

Those not able to receive Holy Communion are most welcome to pray with us. Those unable to receive should remain in their place in prayer during the procession for Holy Communion. Catholic Christians who are able to receive should make a bow in reverence before receiving and answer the ministers’ invitation of “The Body of Christ” with the clear answer “Amen”.

Our clear response of AMEN indicates that we say yes to Jesus in the Eucharist, and to God’s plan for our salvation.

For those unable to receive, including children who have not made their first Communion, at the end of Mass, at the final blessing, a blessing is imparted to all present as prescribed in the Roman Missal for Mass.

I am very happy to share that we have exceeded the parish goal for Saint Augustine~Saint Francis Xavier for the 2026 Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) of **\$57,015**. Faith Formation Registration

Happily, we provide Faith Formation to the families we serve. Children are formed in our Catholic Faith by their parents/guardians at home, by praying at Mass and by attending a formal faith formation program. Children in public and private schools, grades 1-8, learn about our faith two full years prior to First Penance and Holy Communion, and by completing 6 years of class while attending Mass weekly before receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. 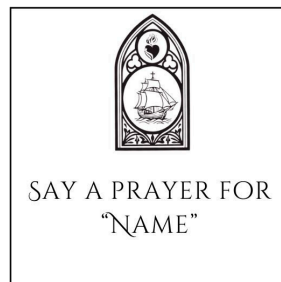

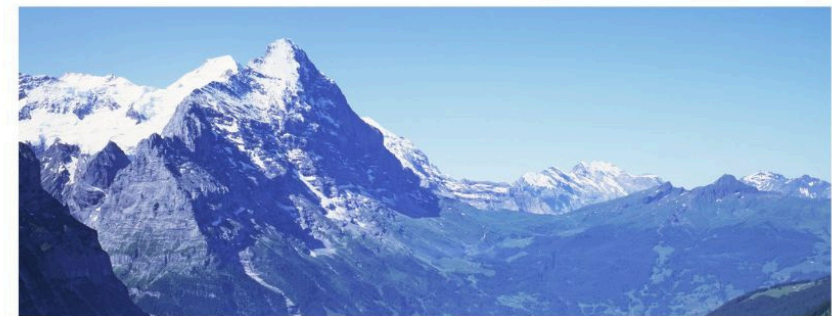
